Re: **CM/ECF Version 3.3.2**

The CM/ECF system, including PACER and VCIS, will be down for maintenance Tuesday October 13, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m.. We are converting the CM database from version 3.3.1 to 3.3.2.

The upgrade to CM/ECF 3.3.2 has several enhancements and changes. In this release, CM/ECF has been further modified to:

- refine the language of the message electronic filers see when they log in to the system;
- require an acknowledgment that the filer has read and will comply with the redaction requirements;
- provide links to the Federal Rules regarding redaction, and
- display another reminder each time the filer actually files a document

The refined message displayed at login will read:

IMPORTANT NOTICE OF REDACTION RESPONSIBILITY: All filers must redact: Social Security or taxpayer-identification numbers; dates of birth; names of minor children; and financial account numbers, in compliance with Fed.R.Bankruptcy.P.9037. This requirement applies to all documents, including attachments.

I understand that, if I file, I must comply with the redaction rules. I have read this notice.

Note: The filer cannot complete the login process without checking the box on the last line of the message.

The citations to the rules will be hyperlinks which, if clicked, take the filer to the text of the rule. In addition, another reminder message has been added to the screen where the filer finalizes submission of the filed document. That message says, "have you redacted?" No affirming keystroke is required for that message.

CM/ECF Release 3.3.2 will require an update to your bankruptcy preparation software. Contact your software vendor to be certain you receive the upgrade prior to October 13, 2009.
