**MOTIONS TO DISMISS**

Bankruptcy Rule 2002(a)(4) requires that all creditors receive 20 days notice by mail of the hearing on a motion to dismiss. The only time that notice does not need to go to all creditors, is when a Chapter 12 or 13 debtor voluntarily dismisses their case. (See also Bankruptcy Rule 1017, 11 U.S.C. § 1307, 11 U.S.C. § 707, 11 U.S.C. § 1112 and 11 U.S.C. § 1208).

**MOTION TO DISMISS** (other than by Chapter 12 or Chapter 13 debtor)

File the Motion to Dismiss with the Clerk. Our office will then prepare a notice of hearing scheduling a hearing with at least 20 days notice. The Clerk's office will then forward to the movant, a copy of the notice, the matrix on pre-printed labels and an instruction sheet. After you have made service, please forward an affidavit of service.
