Various general orders have been entered by this court throughout the years regarding practice and internal operating procedures of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, District of North Dakota. The vast majority of these general orders have become Local Rules of the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of North Dakota, however, some general orders in existence have neither been implemented as a local rule nor revoked by this court. In an effort to clarify those general orders that remain in effect, the court hereby

ORDERS that all previous general orders of this court are REVOKED with the exception of the following:

Standing Order entered January 4, 1995, designating bankruptcy judge for the District of North Dakota to conduct jury trials.

General Order entered October 25, 1996 regarding orders grantable by the clerk and orders imprinted by the clerk.

Standing Order entered August 14, 1997 authorizing Bankruptcy Appellate Panel.

General Order entered April 6, 2001, exempting all individual case trustees, standing trustees and panel trustee members from the PACER per minute usage fee.

Standing Order entered May 24, 2002, regarding appearance of language interpreters.

General Order entered August 5, 2004, regarding recusal of Judge William A. Hill in Timothy Hill cases.

General Orders entered October 13, 2005, October 14, 2005 and September 26, 2006,

adopting Interim Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

This Order entered March 14, 2008, revoking previous local rules effective April 7, 2008.

Order entered March 14, 2008 adopting Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure for the District of North Dakota, effective April 7, 2008.

This order is effective April 7, 2008.
