**ORDER ADOPTING LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES**

**IT IS ORDERED:** The local rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of North Dakota, are revised and amended. These rules are declared to be the practice rules applicable to all bankruptcy cases filed in the District of North Dakota and are reprinted at this time for the convenience of counsel.

These rules are intended to supplement the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Title 11 of the United States Code and any other federal titles referring to bankruptcy matters, and shall be operative and effective in this Court. All previous local rules of the Court governing bankruptcy procedure are hereby revoked effective April 7, 2008.

Any local rule is subject to modification upon application or on the Court's own motion for cause.

These Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure shall become effective on April 7, 2008.
