**ORDER RESCINDING ADOPTION OF INTERIM RULES AND FORMS
AND REVISIONS TO INTERIM RULES**

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2005, the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the "Act") was enacted into law; and

WHEREAS, most provisions of the Act were effective on October 17, 2005; and

WHEREAS, by an order entered on October 13, 2005, this court adopted Interim Local Rules prepared by the Judicial Conference Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules and approved by the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure; and

WHEREAS, by an order entered on October 14, 2005, this court adopted Amendments to the Interim Bankruptcy Rules and Forms prepared by the Judicial Conference Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules and approved by the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure; and

WHEREAS, by an order entered on September 29, 2006, this court adopted revisions to the Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1007 as prepared by the Judicial Conference Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules and approved by the Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the following new rules and amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure will take effect on December 1, 2008, superceding the Interim Rules previously adopted by this court as noted above:

Bankruptcy Rules 1005, 1006, 1007, 1009, 1010, 1011, 1015, 1017, 1019, 1020, 2002, 2003, 2007.1, 2015, 3002, 3003, 3016, 3017.1, 3019, 4002, 4003, 4004, 4006, 4007, 4008, 5001, 5003, 6004, 7012, 7022, 7023.1, 8001, 8003, 9006, 9009, and 9024, and new Bankruptcy Rules 1021, 2007.2, 2015.1, 2015.2, 2015.3, 5008, and 6011.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Interim Rules and Forms, adopted by this court on October 13, 2005, October 14, 2005, and September 29, 2006, except Interim Rule 5012, are rescinded effective December 1, 2008.
