- 1. Access the court's training database at http://ecf-train.ndb.uscourts.gov. Login using the user ID and password that you received via e-mail.
- 2. Using the method of your choice, prepare a Voluntary Petition (Form B1). *HINT: Please* remember that all files (other than the matrix) must be in pdf format.

Open a new voluntary Chapter 7 bankruptcy case using the following information *HINT: Be* sure to use Open BK Case and let the system generate the case number.

- 4. Create a creditor matrix containing at least 3 creditors. *HINT: The matrix must be saved as an ASCII Text file.* Upload the creditor matrix file.
- 5. Write down the case number of the new case.

Exercise #2

- 1. In the case that you opened in exercise #1, file a Motion to Avoid Lien, Notice of Motion and Certificate of Service on behalf of the debtor against any one of the creditors on the creditor matrix. *HINT: A 3-part event is available that allows you to file documents using one event.*
